3. While baking cookies with my grandma, she asked me to double the recipe. If this recipe makes 12 cookies, how much would double be?

4. Your mom took you to the candy store and gave you \$32 to spend. Each piece of candy costs \$4. How many pieces of candy can you buy?

# Math Word Problems Answer Sheet

Read the problems below then solve them. Be sure to show your work.



1. If you make 4 snowballs and your friend makes 8 snowballs, how many more snowballs would you need to make to have 20 snowballs altogether?

$$4 + 8 = 12$$

$$20 - 12 = 8$$

*8 snowballs*

2. It was 45 degrees this morning when I left the house. Now it is 38 degrees. How many degrees colder did it get outside today?

$$45 - 38 = 7$$

*7 degrees*

3. While baking cookies with my grandma, she asked me to double the recipe. If this recipe makes 12 cookies, how much would double be?

$$12 \times 2 = 24$$

*24 cookies*

4. Your mom took you to the candy store and gave you \$32 to spend. Each piece of candy costs \$4. How many pieces of candy can you buy?

$$32 / 4 = 8$$

*8 pieces*
